Village of Brownville Standard Operating Procedures for Sweeping Streets, Parking Lots, Bridges, Parking Lots & Rights-of-Way

All streets, bridges, parking lots, and rights-of-way owned by the Village of Brownville are swept by Jefferson County as part of a shared service agreement. Both relevant departments coordinate to ensure seamless execution of cleaning operations while minimizing disruptions to traffic and daily activities. All sweeping equipment is operated, maintained and stored by Jefferson County. Sweeping and cleaning operations are conducted at least twice annually between April 1st and October 31st, once in the spring and once in the fall, aligning with NYS storm water management requirements. The Village of Brownville inspects, cleans and maintains outfalls within the Village limits twice a year.
